Title: Assistant Psychologist

Description: Chrysalis Associates are an independent multi-disciplinary therapeutic team who specialise in the assessment and treatment of developmental trauma and attachment difficulties in children. We are currently looking for an energetic and enthusiastic Assistant Psychologist to join our team.

This role involves working alongside our team of clinical psychologists and trauma and attachment therapists to provide detailed assessments of children's complex needs (including diagnostic assessments for ASD, ADHD and FASD). The role also involves running online Therapeutic Parenting groups and facilitating individual therapy programs based around CBT, Mindfulness and Sensory Regulation approaches. There are many additional opportunities for service-evaluation and research within the team.

We recognise that people from Black, Asian and other racial/ethnic groups that may be a minority within the UK, are under-represented in the profession of psychology, and would like to strongly invite individuals from these communities to apply for this post.

We are looking for candidates with:

- A Psychology degree recognised by the BPS (ideally 2:1 or above).
- Experience of working with children with emotional and behavioural difficulties, in particular children living in foster or adoptive families or in residential care.
- Experience administering and analysing psychometric measures.
- A good understanding of Attachment Theory.
- Excellent report-writing skills.
- Good organisational skills, flexibility and autonomy.

The post is based in our Sheffield office but will involve frequent travel to our other therapy bases in Grantham, York and Bradford. A current UK driving licence and access to your own car is essential.
