DESCRIPTION	<p>Chrysalis Associates are an independent multi-disciplinary therapeutic team and a regional centre of excellence in the assessment and treatment of developmental trauma and attachment difficulties in children. The team is led by two Clinical Psychologists and we are currently looking for an energetic and enthusiastic Clinical Psychologist to join our assessment team on an associate basis to complete fetal alcohol spectrum disorder assessments.</p> <p>This role involves undertaking detailed psychological assessments of children and young people's complex needs, including assessments of neurodiverse conditions, as well as cognitive functioning and memory, and trauma and attachment difficulties. We have offices based in Sheffield and Grantham with face-to-face assessment measures completed by our team of Assistant Psychologists. As part of this role you would be a member of the multidisciplinary assessment team, and will be completing FASD assessments as a lead clinician.</p> <p>We recognise that people from Black, Asian and other racial/ethnic groups that may be a minority within the UK are under-represented in our field, and would like to strongly invite individuals from these communities to apply for this post. This post would be supervised by a cisgender male Clinical Psychologist who identifies as White British. Support can also be provided by a cisgender female Clinical Psychologist who identifies as mixed race, British Nigerian, or by a cisgender female Clinical Psychologist who identifies as White British.</p> <p>We are looking for candidates with:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A Doctorate in Clinical Psychology. Experience of administering and analysing psychometric assessment measures. Experience of working with children with emotional and behavioural difficulties, in particular children living in foster or adoptive families or in residential care. A good understanding of Attachment Theory. Experience administering and analysing psychometric measures. Experience of completing diagnostic assessments for children. Excellent report-writing skills. Good organisational skills, flexibility and autonomy.
