PURPOSE OF ROLE	To provide diagnostic FASD assessments to children and families.
REPSONSIBILITIES	<p>To complete 2-hour developmental history and intake interview sessions with parents and caregivers. To write an accurate account of this meeting into the child's report.</p> <p>To analyse, interpret, and write diagnostic assessment conclusions using evidence from the developmental history, standardised assessment measures, and psychometric tests.</p> <p>To attend multi-disciplinary team meetings concerning all assessment cases.</p> <p>To complete 1-hour assessment feedback meetings with parents/caregivers and professionals around the child, outlining and explaining the outcome of any diagnostic decision, the assessment report, and next steps for the child. In these meetings, to provide advice, consultation and training to professionals around working with children with FASD, developmental trauma, and attachment difficulties.</p> <p>To attend individual and team Clinical Supervision remotely.</p> <p>To undertake appropriate training and other CPD activities in relation to the work carried out.</p> <p>To undertake training in additional assessment and therapeutic techniques as required by the service.</p> <p>To undertake correspondence and note-keeping as appropriate.</p> <p>To adhere to the standards laid down by Chrysalis Associates Ltd concerning the management of all written material and keeping of clinical information.</p> <p>To abide by all Professional Policies, Procedures and Guidelines of Chrysalis Associates Ltd.</p>
